eTeck Joins the Ministry of Land and Legal Affairs to Drive National Growth

In a strategic move to eliminate bureaucracy and accelerate national development, the Government of Trinidad and Tobago has officially transitioned Evolving TecKnologies and Enterprise Development Company Limited (eTeck) to the Ministry of Land and Legal Affairs (MLLA). This transition is designed to leverage eTeck's significant land holdings to provide unparalleled land security and streamlined investment processes.

The Honourable Saddam Hosein, M.P., Minister of Land and Legal Affairs and Minister in the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries, now assumes responsibility for eTeck. This transition incorporates the state enterprise into his existing ministerial portfolio. Minister Hosein expressed gratitude to the Prime Minister's strategic vision for this transition, noting that her leadership has been instrumental in modernising the state's approach to land administration and investment.

At the heart of this transition is eTeck's extensive portfolio of approximately 2,915 hectares of land. This includes developed, reserve, and future strategic sites across 22 industrial parks, notably the 1,100-acre Tamana InTech Park, as well as the Magdalena Grand and Hilton Trinidad. By realigning these significant holdings under the Ministry of Land and Legal Affairs (MLLA), the Government is creating a "one-stop shop" for land administration. This move directly benefits tenants by accelerating lease processing, consolidating data, and enhancing title security, all of which are critical for securing the private financing and long-term capital investment necessary for industrial growth.

Minister Hosein said, "No more chasing the same documents through endless offices. Now, investing in an eTeck park means total confidence in a digital, streamlined framework, fueling business growth and jobs for citizens."

This consolidation ensures that the "land-to-investment" pipeline is shorter, more transparent, and more attractive to both local and international investors.
